The state of Minnesota has recently launched a free COVID-19 exposure notification app. COVIDaware MN is a downloadable app that can anonymously notify you if you have come in contact with someone who has

Free Testing. The Minnesota Department of Health has introduced a COVID-19 saliva test that is now available at sites across the state and is also available for in home testing. These tests are free for anyone who believes they need to be tested, whether they are showing symptoms or not. There are also free community testing sites all over the State.
